- The terms you specify on this form must match the choices you make in both the institutional repository ScholarWorks (IR publishing options) and ProQuest (PQ publishing options).
- Most students choose not to embargo, but there are some instances where it might be

Embargo Options for Thesis, Dissertation

William & Mary allows embargo for up to 12-years on a thesis or dissertation. Or you may opt not to restrict the release of your work. An extended embargo of more than 2 years (3-12) requires review and approval by the Assistant Dean of Graduate Studies. In the event that the Assistant Dean declines an embargo request, the graduate director for the student's program may appeal the decision. The Assistant Dean is required to bring such an appeal before the CDSP Committee on Graduate Studies for discussion and a vote. An embargo of more than 6 years also requires consultation with and signature from the Digital Scholarship Librarian or similar W&M Libraries staff.
