Undergraduate students at William & Mary may take graduate-level courses (numbered 500 and above) for credit toward the bachelor's degree, provided:

- Student has a GPA of at least 2.5 overall and 3.0 in the subject field of the course
- Student has taken the appropriate prerequisites
- Material in the graduate-level course is relevant to the student's program and is not available in the undergraduate curriculum

Instructions

- 1. Complete one form for each graduate course.
- 2. Obtain the signature of the instructor of the graduate course.
- 3. Obtain the signature of that school's graduate dean or representative.
- 4. Attach a copy of your DegreeWorks.
- 5. Obtain the signature of the undergraduate dean representative for your major.
- 6. Return the complete form to the Registrar's Office.

Deadline: The completed form (with DegreeWorks) is due before the end of Add/Drop.

If the petition is approved, the Registrar's Office will send a notification of enrollment in the course.
